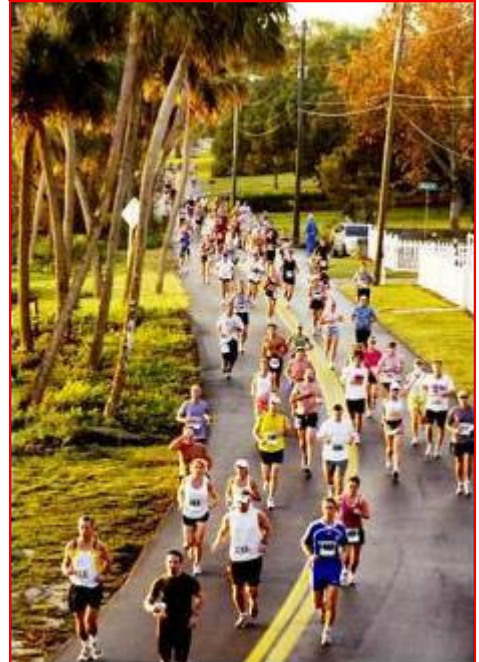

# THE PASSING LANE

*With Ron Hoar*  
**Taking Your Running**  
**(and the realization of your potential)**  
**to A Higher Level**



Last month I told you about the discovery of my first degree AV block--that's where the electrical impulse in the heart is delayed beyond the acceptable .2 seconds. I've seen my local doctor, had an in-office EKG which showed no block and wore a Holter monitor for 24 hours.

There is still more to the story but since it is still developing I'll wait until next month to let you know what lessons we runners might learn from my incident.

So this month I go back to the beginning of my running--how it all began for me. All of us who became serious about our running and fitness had a starting point. For some it begins with high school and/or college track or cross county. For me it was different. Busy with high school basketball and baseball I did not even consider running in those days.

After college there were the years devoted to building a career and family and no exercising. At about age 40 I began to see an emerging double chin when I looked in the mirror to shave. With the additional urging of my first wife, I began to do a limited amount of running. That was

pretty much hit or miss. Then, after moving to Texas and a warmer climate than Maine, I began to run a little more regularly.

On my 49<sup>th</sup> birthday I vowed to run nine miles that day and then to add an additional mile each birthday thereafter for the next 10 years. So at age 50 I would run 10 miles, at age 51 it would be 11 miles, etc.

Apparently that jump started me toward better physical fitness and one month after my 50<sup>th</sup> birthday I ran my first race. Following is a story that I wrote in 1990 for my company's (JCPenney) running club newsletter.

*At 5:30 A.M. on September 4, 1988 I dashed through the rain, jumped in my car and headed for Arlington Stadium. As the rain poured down from the pre-dawn sky, my speed slowed to about 30 mph. My eyes focused on the white center line of the highway, but my mind was questioning why I would want to go through all this for my first road race. It was so dark and difficult to see that I missed two turns on the way.*

*I had been a fair weather casual jogger for about 15 years but now, at age 50 no less, I was ready to try a race. My training runs of 5- to 6-miles three times a week would be put to the test.*

*About the time I arrived in Arlington the rain tapered to a sprinkle. I got my race number but didn't know anyone around me. My nervousness increased. How fast should I go? Could I finish? Would I be the last to come over the finish line?*

*Soon the runners were off. Water was still running in the streets of the 5-mile course. After a couple of miles my shoes got heavy from the water, but I just tried to run my own race.*

*Jubilation! I finished! Not last! No trophy, but a respectable 39:10 time and a 7:48 pace.*

*I've run 3,000 miles since that first race--41 races including three marathons. Twenty of those got me "hardware" and in March I set my PR for a 10k of 39:24 with a 6:20 pace. But qualifying and running the Boston Marathon is my greatest thrill. As a youngster in Maine I never dreamed that I could ever do that--it was something that only a very few strange athletes could physically do.*

*Yes, I wanted to get better over the past 20 months, but surprisingly I didn't have a specific goal in mind except to perhaps be able to run the marathon distance.*

*What I relearned in those months is that desire, the will to achieve and dedicated hard work can make things happen (in running and in your life too).*

*I have no doubt in my mind that many others can do what I did and probably a lot better. And you don't have to apply it just to running. Mental and physical discipline can take you wherever you want to go!*

**If you have been just a casual jogger--it's not too late to pick up the pace. As many will testify--frequent racing can be life changing--both physically and mentally. Go for it in 2010!**

# RUNNERS' REVIEW

## Product: Firefly Supernova

Fireflies are not just winged beetles with bioluminescent rear ends used to attract mates; Road ID has created a lightweight safety light, the Firefly™ Supernova, for walkers, runners and bikers. From the Road ID website: “This little fella packs quite a punch. Simply put, it's the brightest, lightest, most durable security light in its class. Other lights just don't compare. You won't believe how bright this safety light is. Its durable plastic clip enables you to securely attach it to your waistband, belt or even your shirt collar. Wear it whenever you go out at dark and be seen by motorists from up to a mile away.”

Firefly Supernovas are available in red, blue, green and clear. They come standard with a robust plastic clip and for a few dollars more a version with a 3M Scotchlite reflective velcro wrist/ankle band is available. The batteries are included and are simple to replace. The internal circuitry is designed to alternate between flash and constant mode depending on which direction the batteries are installed. The Supernova is also waterproof up to 300ft, which is great for late night aqua joggers that are paranoid about getting hit by cars.

Our personal experience with the Supernovas has been positive. They are very light and unobtrusive and it would be easy to forget we were wearing them if it wasn't for the bright strobe. Motorists notice us much sooner than they used to. In fact, many of them turn on their brights to figure out what's flashing at them. We have even had motorists travelling in the other direction turn around to glare at what they had mistaken as a blinking Christmas tree on the run. There is one rule of etiquette to remember when using the Supernovas and running with other people. Position the light in a direction that isn't flashing in someone's face, but can be seen by oncoming traffic.

Although this review spotlights the Firefly, the real message is safety and wearing any safety light in the dark is a “bright” idea. We are now in the daylight savings time months and fitting in a run during the daylight hours can be a challenge. Safety becomes a compounded concern in Florida during the fall and winter months because of a very dangerous species of migratory fowl... snow birds. Safety lights are a simple way to be responsible for personal safety by increasing your visibility to those sharing roads and walkways.

While the holiday season is a joyous time for many, it is also statistically known as a period of increased accidents. Many people are on the roads and the increased volume of traffic increases risks. Remember to be safe, be seen, be aware and any run is a good run if you can put on your running shoes the next day and do it again.

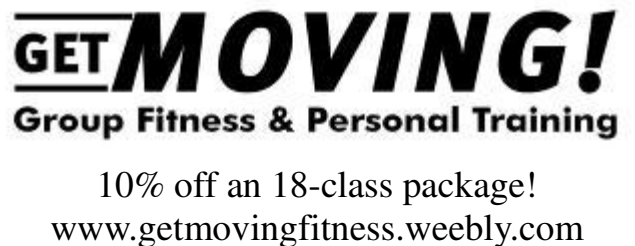

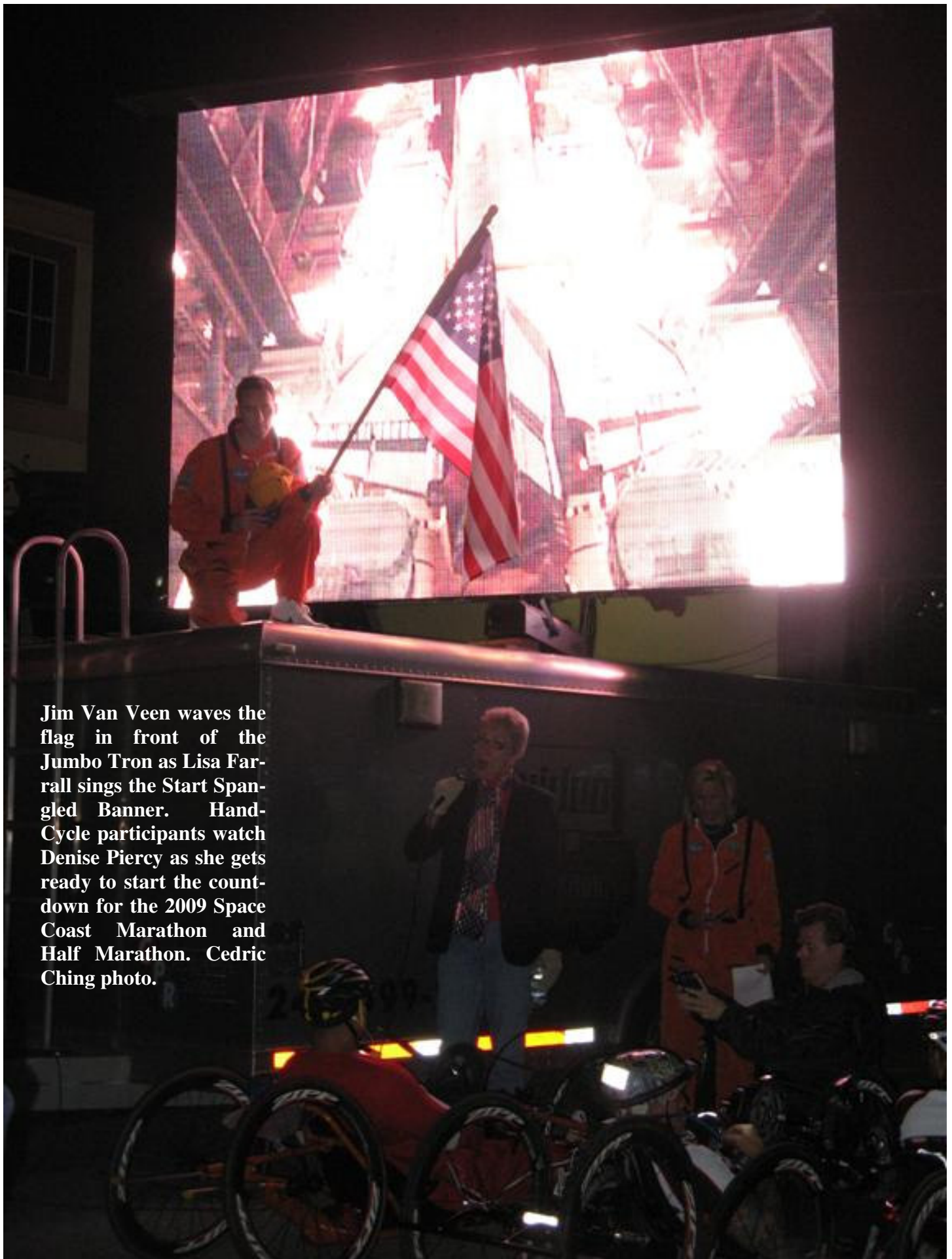

## Running it up

### Record number of entries might hit 2,600 by race day for Space Coast Marathon and Half-Marathon

There could be records set, all right.

Just the number of athletes already registered for Sunday's Space Coast Marathon and Half-Marathon is a mark for the books.

As of Nov. 20, more than 2,000 athletes from 17 countries and 41 states have registered, and race organizers are expecting "2,500 to 2,600" by race day. As a bonus for local business coffers, 70 percent of the field -- many with friends and family in tow -- will be coming from beyond Brevard's borders.

"I believe that we have one of the most unique marathons in the nation," said Don Piercy, co-owner of Running Zone, the event's race management company. "As the race is held within the shadow of the Kennedy Space Center, our entire event revolves around a space theme. What other race offers a race start with a space shuttle countdown and liftoff on a Jumbotron or a chance to take a picture with the astronauts?"

The race also provides space-theme aid stations and costumed volunteers at each mile along the shady course that winds along the Indian River. Participants also receive beach towels, technical race shirts, large astronaut finishers' medals, and a post-race pancake, egg and sausage breakfast.

Neither the race venue nor the quality of participant experience has gone unnoticed. Independent post-race athlete surveys have shown that participants believe Space Coast provides the biggest bang for the buck in terms of value, experience and individual support. And Runners' World magazine dubbed Space Coast "Race of the Month" last year as well as the event with the "Best Schwag" in 2007.

Although only one self-predicted race time -- a 2-hour and 47-minute marathon forecast by St. Petersburg's Melanie Peters -- could break a current course record, race organizers have added pace teams. The new amenity could help a majority of the field run a coveted 'PR,' or personal record.

"Our goal is to create a fun, festive environment where everyone has a great time," said Piercy, who thought long and hard before eliminating the prize purse -- normally shared amongst a small number of elite runners -- to bring in the Marathonpacing.com crew. The change was intended to provide support for the average athlete who must balance training time with the demand of full-time jobs, kids and aging parents.

Pace group leaders are chosen for their motivating personalities and years of endurance experience that allows them to lead their charges to the finish line on an even keel.

While most sports disallow outside assistance, USA Track and Field -- the sport's national governing body -- allows for pacing as long as the three criteria of rule 144.3 are met: That the pacesetter be officially designated, entered in the event for that purpose and start with the field. Athletes who are paced by friends or coaches not meeting each of those criteria can and have been disqualified.

"About 20 percent of the race is mental," said Jim Crist, who founded the Pittsburgh company that provides teams for more than 20 races around the country. "Running with a group who is sharing a common goal while being encouraged by the pace leader provides that extra boost."

"We've had many athletes tell us that they had tried several times to qualify for Boston but didn't quite make it until they ran with one of our teams."

About 30 minutes prior to the start of Sunday's race, pace leaders will be assembling athletes who wish to run with them in the starting area on Brevard Avenue. Each pace leader will be holding up a white sign with a marathon goal time on one side and a pace-per-mile on the other for those running the half marathon.

Crist cautioned that athletes pick their pace teams based on actual previous performance. He also encouraged athletes to stop by their booth at the pre-race Expo if they are considering following a pace leader.

"We do half of the important work the day or two before the race by talking with the runners," he said. "We want athletes to come and talk with us about their goals and training. We will do our best to answer any questions and advise them on the best pace group."

"We can't magically make a Boston qualifier appear; but if you have trained and have it in you, a good pace leader will help get the best that you're capable of putting out."

## Stilt runner goes for world record

Orlando's Rory Helzer will be racing head and shoulders above the field Sunday as he attempts to break six world records while contesting the 26.2-mile Space Coast course on a pair of 44-inch aluminum stilts.

Helzer is hoping to earn the nod as the fastest person to cover one mile, 5K, 8K, 10K, half-marathon and marathon on a pair of conventional (nonspring-loaded) stilts. To trounce current world records, he'll need to hit the first mile in less than 12 minutes and 23 seconds and then beat a 19:15 minute per mile for the marathon.

Helzer, who took up stilt-walking as a Halloween bar gag about 30 years ago, filed his intent with Guinness World Records and will be accompanied along the route by a videographer to document his stilted feat.

"I want to prove to myself that I am as good as my fans say I am," said the 50-year-old father of two, who has collected devotees worldwide from his gigs as a dancing security guard and stilt-walking entertainer for Universal Studios Orlando.

After cranking out 26.2 miles, Helzer will continue his trek a bit farther -- 75 miles, in fact -- to Universal Studios Orlando for a potential seventh world record.

"I'd like to set the record for the longest distance on stilts in 24 hours," said Helzer, who will be accompanied by a small support crew to provide nutrition, lighting and traffic support on his journey to Orlando. "Being on stilts for 24 hours is not a big deal; walking on stilts for 24 hours is."

## Local pace specialist has time on his side

Indialantic's Jim Schroeder is a human metronome.

Sunday, the 62-year-old Harris Corp. research scientist will lead multiple marathon and half-marathon runners to the finish line at a prescribed pace of 10 minutes, 18 seconds per mile. That's a marathon time of 4:30; 2:15 for the half.

"There is self-pressure," said Schroeder, the only local resident running as a pace team leader. "I strive to hit the (finish) 30 seconds or less under the desired goal."

Schroeder, whose race credentials include multiple marathons, five 50Ks, two 50-milers and one 100- miler, relies on a Garmin GPS to provide continual feedback on pace, time and distance. But just in case technology fails, he also wears a standard chronograph watch as well as a pace band displaying the pre-computed cumulative time for each mile split.

"The chrono serves as a backup in case of a Garmin failure as happened to me in the San Diego Rock 'n' Roll Marathon last May," said Schroeder, who leads pace teams at races throughout the country. "In that case, I estimated my pace and cross-checked each mile split to make corrections. I finished the 5-hour goal in 4:59:31, obtaining a reasonable pacing accuracy."

While Rory finished the marathon in 9:22:10, his one-mile, 5K, 8K, 10K, half-marathon and marathon splits did not break any current Guinness records. One thing that Rory didn't realize was that to break those records, the Space Coast course could not contain any elevation changes exceeding one percent.

## **First time's a charm for marathoner** **Georgian, a rookie to marathons, wins 26.2-miler; local woman takes half**

Matthew May came into Sunday's Space Coast Marathon having never run a full 26.2-mile event. But he knew one thing about himself.

"The longer I go, the better I get," the 25-year-old from Athens, Ga., said.

That certainly proved to be the case, as May easily outdistanced the field, crossing the finish line at Cocoa Village's Riverfront Park in 2 hours, 37 minutes, 58 seconds.

Renae Cicchinelli, who was worried that she had set too fast a pace for herself in the early portion of the race, took the women's title in 2:59:01.

Boca Raton's Jon Volpi won the men's half-marathon in 1:10:45, while Beth Whalen of Melbourne was the top woman with a time of 1:26:05. Meredith Van Veen, also of Melbourne, was second in 1:28:47.

The 38th annual event drew 2,484 competitors -- including a man on stilts -- and was run under near perfect conditions. The temperature was about 50 degrees at the 6 a.m. start, and the wind was minimal.

"Last year, it was really hot and windy," Volpi said. "This year, I actually ran alone the entire race all the way, and my time was actually better this year. I think everyone's time will be better this year because it was cooler. It was actually a perfect day."

Volpi, the only one of Sunday's four winners who had run the race before, was trying to complete some unfinished business.

"I was second last year," the 26-year-old said. "I was back for more. Mission accomplished."

The 23-year-old Whalen, who moved to Melbourne from Bettendorf, Iowa, in July, has been making a name for herself on the local running scene. Sunday's win added to that fact.

"I ran a 15K about three weeks ago and tore up my feet pretty bad because I ran in flats that I probably shouldn't have run in," she said. "So I was nervous for today. I didn't know how my feet were going to feel. I've been taking it easy, cross training and pretty much nursing it.

"I felt amazing. It was almost a blessing in disguise. It made me taper better than I usually do."

Cicchinelli, 29, had been planning to run the Palm Beaches Marathon next weekend but decided to push up her race schedule because of a hamstring issue that has been bothering her for the past year.

"Somebody told me this was a really good (race) -- and it is," the Haines City resident said.

Taking control halfway through the race, she finished well ahead of second-place Maite Moscoso of Longwood, who had a time of 3:06:09. However, Cicchinelli was worried early that she was setting too fast a pace for herself.

"The last six miles, my times started slowing," she said. "I think I took the first half a little too fast. I even had a 6:11 mile, which is way too fast. But it was pretty steady after mile 17."

May, who had previously only run half-marathons, started training six months ago to run 26.2 miles.

He decided to run the Space Coast event because he has relatives in the area and, like Cicchinelli, had heard good things about the race.

He took the lead at the 10-mile mark and finished nearly seven minutes ahead of second-place Lee Rietsma of Tampa.

"I felt good until about mile 23, and that's when it hit me that . . . this is the real deal," May said. "(I told myself), 'Three miles to go. You run 5Ks all the time.' "

Merritt Island's Thaddeus Austin was the top local finisher in the men's marathon, finishing in 2:58:41, which was good enough for second in the 30 to 39 age group.

Melbourne's Cheng Ten was the first local woman to cross the line in the marathon. Her time was 3:20:56, which was second in the 35 to 39 age group.

Melbourne's John Davis was the top local men's finisher in the half-marathon, finishing fourth overall in 1:20:17 and winning his age group (30 to 34). Steve Chin of Satellite Beach won the Men's Masters Division in 1:21:31.

Orlando's Rory Helzer, who was attempting to break several world records for running a marathon on stilts, did not complete the race.

The mood of the day was perhaps best summed up by a little girl who ran alongside her father as he labored toward the finish line nearly six hours after the race started. "Daddy," she said, "I'm so proud of you."

## Key to fast, injury-free running: walking

How can you argue with a man who on Sunday ran his 148th marathon? How can you argue with a man who started running in 1958 and who, at age 64, has never had an injury?

You can't.

And so when I learned that Jeff Galloway, an author and a 1972 Olympian who is known as "America's Coach," was offering his running school in Melbourne, I knew I had to attend.

Of the almost 2,500 runners in the Space Coast Marathon and Half-Marathon on Sunday, only 25 attended the Saturday classroom with Galloway. They ranged from 20-somethings to seniors, and all of them seemed clued in to the benefits of Galloway's run-walk-run method of training and racing.

"I'm convinced that this method can keep almost anyone injury-free, almost all of the time," said Galloway, who claims to have coached more than a quarter of a million runners since he first developed the method in 1974. "It gives one control over fatigue, injury prevention and recovery."

A few years ago, I wrote about a group of local women who travel around together doing long races. They are housewives and grandmothers, not typical competitive athletes. The wowed me in that they accomplish the miles in the run-walk-run format.

I struggled to try the method myself, accustomed as I was to pacing and pushing to the extreme. Walking just didn't seem acceptable.

But the numbers don't lie. These women finished distances I could not run without stopping. That is Galloway's premise.

"Time-goal runners are surprised to find out that when nonstop runners shift to my method, the average marathon time improves by more than 13 minutes and more than six minutes in the half," he said.

Galloway said about 120 runners have contacted him during the past 10 years to tell him that they've broken the three-hour mark in the marathon using his method.

"Most were dead-set against it," he said, adding most athletes opposed his methods for fear of looking like wimps. Eventually, he said, they switched because "they were beaten by someone who did it."

Galloway offers guidelines depending on the distance and desired pace, but he said you have to experiment to see what works.

For example, if you are shooting for a 9-minute mile pace in a marathon, he suggests running for four minutes and walking for one. A 10-minute mile would be three and one. Cut the race distance, and you can reduce the walk time.

Donah Drewett, 62, of Vermont started running three years ago but has outrun her 42-year-old daughter and 20-year-old granddaughter in races using the method. She started it because she knew she could not run long distances without stopping. And she's faster doing it Galloway's way anyway.

"I went from a 16-minute mile to 12," she said. "It's great, and I don't have any injuries at all... I don't feel like I'm going on Social Security."

Karthin Switzer, who made history by running the then all-male Boston Marathon in 1967, said the marathon once was considered a near-impossible feat, calling it "the Everest of running."

"Jeff Galloway, with his run-walk method, has made the marathon distance a reality for thousands of new runners, showing that size, age and talent are no barriers to the 26.2-mile distance," Switzer said. "By making running so accessible, he has enriched thousands of lives with vastly increased fitness."

Galloway travels the country offering his classroom sessions and also hosts running retreats. He offers special e-mail access to those who take his classes and genuinely loves to share what he has learned about running and staying injury free.

"This is the marvelous thing about running," he said. "Our bodies are genetically programmed to adapt to it."

And it seems thousands of people are adapting to going faster by using the run-walk-run method.
